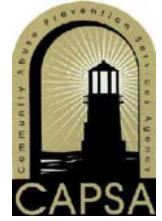

Lezlee Larsen and Vickie Smith, Rape Prevention Educators at CAPSA, will oversee the activities of each committee and provide guidance and direction throughout the duration of the Council.

CAPSA feels this is a great opportunity for your student to develop his or her leadership and communication skills, participate in volunteer service for a non-profit organization, work as a member of a collaborative team with other students in Cache Valley, and build lasting friendships.
