GIFTS OF CASH AND SECURITIES

Help support these local nonprofits immediate program needs with a cash donation. A gift of cash qualifies for a full charitable deduction for most donors who itemize their federal tax return.

A gift of appreciated securities is a popular alternative to a cash gift because it saves taxes twice. You not only receive an income tax deduction for the full fair market value of your securities for more than one year, but you also avoid capital gain tax on the appreciation.

You can name a nonprofit or multiple nonprofits in a will. This will extend your legacy and may create tax advantages for your estate.


